### **Meeting with Mayor Pinson**

The LCPA executive met with Mayor Pinson and the Director of Strategy and Growth Jeff Sharp to discuss the Foreshore Masterplan, Ocean Drive and Revetment Wall.

As a result of this meeting, we have been advised that design work has commenced on Ocean Drive from Miala Street to Orana Drive.

The Foreshore Masterplan "Think Tank" session held with community members and council staff on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> October was a great success and we have been advised the next process will be the presentation of the "Draft Masterplan" at a **Family Fun Day** at the Lake Foreshore.

Mayor Pinson advised that discussion were held between PMHC representatives and the NSW Govt. Minister of Planning to develop a funding model of the revetment. It is expected that this report will be completed by the end of the year.
