• MEETING WITH MAYOR

LCPA Executive have a scheduled meeting with the Mayor and Senior staff in early August, items to be discussed at this meeting will be; Upgrade to Ocean Drive, Revetment Wall and Foreshore Masterplan and in particular when funding will be identified and made available for these major projects that council have approved, but not yet funded. We will report back on any out comes from this meeting in our next newsletter.

• FISHING PLATFORM

LCPA have been advised by PMHC they have applied for an additional grant to complete the installation of the Fishing Table, we will continue to monitor this process with council

• EXERCISE EQUIPMENT



• TRAFFIC COUNT IN LAKE CATHIE

As advised in the last newsletter council were waiting for the report from the consultants who undertook this project. We can now advise we have received this information and have included the map with traffic count details for your information on the following page.

The data is in the form of AADT (Annual Average Daily Traffic). This is the average number of vehicles on a typical day passing a specific point and is used for basic calculations.

Lake Cathie Health Complex has come a long way in the past 10 years. Originally opening its doors in 2008 with a 2 doctor GP practice, the Health Complex now boasts;

- A medical centre that has 13 fully qualified doctors who perform everything from travel vaccination
 advice and chronic disease management to skin checks and skin cancer removals. Most GP's are
 taking new patients. LCMC also has one of the biggest and best nursing units in the area with 5 fully
 qualified nurses taking care of your immunisations, wound management, care planning and ear
 syringing to name a few.
- A dental practice that is headed by Dr Pieter Nieuwoudt. Pieter will take care of all of your dental
 needs including family and cosmetic dentistry, dentures, mouth guards, periodontic treatment and
 crown and bridges. All major health funds are accepted and Hicaps and Eftpos is available for your
 convenience.
- A physio department that has 3 fully qualified physios who are looking forward to moving into bigger premises in the future. Physiotherapy at Lake Cathie Physio involves 1 to 1 physio sessions where explaining your problem, teaching you the right exercises and relieving your pain are the focus of each session. Our Physiotherapists Barry, Sarah and Ashleigh all have extensive experience with a combined 45 years in clinical practice. Sarah has completed specialist training in headache treatment and Ashleigh has completed specialist training in pelvic floor management.

There are also a number of Allied Health & Services that are available for all member of the community, not just patients of the Medical Practice;

- RJ Podiatry are available each Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday. Ryan and Cara see private patients or patients that may have a referral under an EPC management plan
- JK Healthcare provide Dietician and Diabetic Educator services each fortnight.
- Sue Keegan speech pathologists visits the complex on an as need basis
- Alex Meares from Connect Hearing visits the complex each fortnight
- 2 psychologists, Marie-Louise Corin and Rob Davis are available each day at the health complex to see patients.
- Lea Bailey from Optimal Midwifery gives women an option when it comes to antenatal care. Women can choose to conduct their antenatal classes here at the health complex instead of heading to the base hospital. Lea is available on a Monday

On-site there is also an amazing pharmacy that will take care of all your medicinal needs. Karen even offers free home delivery. Laverty pathology are open Monday to Friday and will accept all blood request forms. Panoptic vision are on site for all of your optical needs. Head Optometrist Natasha has completed extensive post graduate training that now sees her a qualified Behavioral Optometrist. Panoptic Vision also have onboard Julie Currie who is a vision therapist that works with children to improve their vision and learning outcomes.
